



House Rules Rütli

Regulations for the use of the Rütli meadow on 1 August

The Rütli, cradle of the Swiss Confederation, was purchased in 1860 by the Schweizerische Gemeinnützige Gesellschaft (SGG) and donated to the Confederation. The SSCG is responsible for the care and management of the Rütli.

In order to ensure that the federal celebrations can be held in a dignified atmosphere, the following points apply:

- + Only official Swiss flags and cantonal flags **are permitted**.

- **It is forbidden** to carry weapons or dangerous objects, banners and propaganda material, megaphones, musical instruments and other sounding bodies, fireworks and other pyrotechnic objects.

Furthermore, please note:

- Dogs **must be kept** on a leash.
- Camping/staying overnight on the Rütli is **prohibited**.
- **Please follow** the instructions of the police and Securitas.
- **Please** leave the Rütli meadow as you found it.
- **Please separate** your rubbish and dispose of it in the special rubbish bins.

The ticket holder agrees that the private security services commissioned are authorised to:

- Check personal details
- Search visitors for objects they have brought and take any dangerous or prohibited objects away from them
- Bar or report visitors who fail to comply with the rules for using the Rütli Meadow
